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## Care & Maintenance for a WOCA Natural Oil Finished Floor

### DAILY:

**Sweep regularly with a dry, soft bristle broom.**

- Many customers “dry dust” with a cotton cover on Swiffer Style mop-head.

### BI-WEEKLY:

**Mop every two weeks with WOCA Natural Soap and a cotton mop.**

- WOCA Natural Soap is sold in 1 liter and 2.5 liter containers as a concentrate.
- Mix 3oz of Natural Soap concentrate per gallon of water. Be sure to dilute properly.

### AS NEEDED:

**WOCA Natural Soap Spray for quick touch up.**

- Available in White or Natural.
- Can be refilled using WOCA Natural Soap Concentrate. We suggest distilled water for mixing.

### Every 4-6 MONTHS:

- WOCA Oil Refresher is used only 2-3 times per year in place of Natural Soap Mopping, for most residential settings. It is also available as a spray formula for higher traffic areas, like the kitchen sink and/or entry areas.

**If a floor has been neglected and spots develop, WOCA offers two terrific products:**

- WOCA Tannin Spot Remover, for water spots.
- WOCA Spot Remover, for coffee, wine, and tea spills.
- After the use of either of these two products, light, touch up re-oiling with coordinating WOCA Maintenance Oil is required.

### Cleaning Tips:

- WOCA recommends using cotton mops or cotton “Swiffer-style” covers.
- Vacuuming without using a beater bar brush is acceptable.
- It's been noted that long term use of microfiber can create scratch patterns.

***Proper disposal of any oiled rag is important, as they are combustible. Place oiled rags in a plastic bag, soak with water and dispose outside.***
